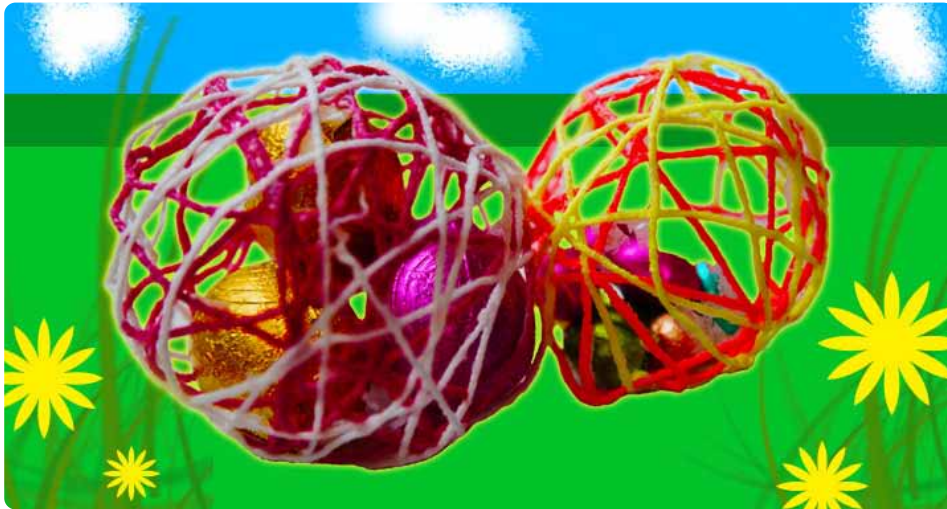


Make an Easter nest surprise



You will need

- ✓ Mini chocolate eggs
- ✓ Balloon
- ✓ PVA glue
- ✓ Bowl
- ✓ Water
- ✓ Coloured thread or string
- ✓ Needle

Introduction

Instructions

Step 1



Grab your balloon and blow it up a couple of times to stretch it out and let it deflate. Then pop your chocolate eggs inside the balloon. If this is too difficult you can add them in step 6.

Step 2



Blow up your balloon to around the size of a melon and then tie a knot in the end.

Step 3



Mix some PVA glue with water in an old bowl, take a piece of thread and dip it in the glue mixture and pass through your fingers to coat it all in glue.

Step 4



Start wrapping the glue covered string around your balloon until it is covered. Leave a few gaps but make sure they aren't bigger than a chocolate mini egg.

Step 5



Once it looks similar to this, leave to dry.

Step 6



Once dry pop the balloon and carefully remove from inside the nest. You may need to cut away extra balloon which sticks to the thread. If you haven't added your chocolate eggs you can add them now by pushing them through one of the holes.

Step 7



Your nest is now ready to give as a gift to family or friends. Happy Easter!
