- ✓ Different coloured wax crayons
- ✓ PVA Glue
- ✓ Canvas or thick card
- ✓ Hairdryer (Don't forget to get your parent or guardian's permission first)

Introduction

Instructions

Step 1



Decide on a design for your art and stick your crayons onto your canvas or card using PVA glue and leave to dry.

Step 2



Find a suitable area near a plug for your hairdryer and cover with old newspapers.

Step 3



Hold the hairdryer in the direction you want the crayons to run, be very careful as the wax will be hot, ask an adult to help if necessary. Keep going until you have the pattern you want.

Step 4



Once your artwork is dry it is ready to be hung on your wall or given as a gift.
