

SITTING PRETTY



To learn this trick, the dog has to know how to sit.



From a sitting position, coax the dog to lift one paw up by offering a treat.



Use the click to let the dog know when she's done the right thing.



Then, try coaxing the dog to lift both paws up.



Don't get frustrated if your dog doesn't learn the trick straight away.



The most important thing is to show the dog lots of love and to enjoy life with your dog!



ZAK'S QUICK TRICKS

ROLL OVER
SPIN

Encourage your dog and have lots of fun teaching them!



Most dogs are far more intelligent than people realise and can learn right and left.

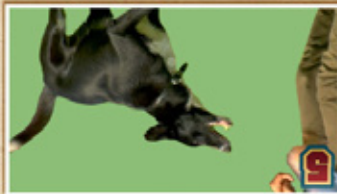


When training your dog, make it worth their while by using a treat or a toy to encourage them.



SPIN

When they understand the difference between left and right, mix it up a little!



Say 'left spin' to encourage them to turn left and 'right spin' to move right.



For spin, use the toy to encourage your dog to move.



Always let your dog know you appreciate them and show them lots of love.



Only say 'roll over' when the dog has done the trick, as it's a new command.



Coax the dog to roll-over using the treat. Using a treat the dog likes will help them learn quickly.



ROLL OVER

Be very patient. This trick could take a while to learn.



Don't try and force or push the dog over. It may frighten the dog and they won't ever learn the trick.



Zak uses meat as a treat to train dogs for this trick. Start from the lie down position.
