



Mister Maker

Big Head Masks



You will need

A ruler
Green paper
Brown paper
A glue stick
Sticky tape
Scissors (grown-up use only)
A pen

1

Cut two strips of green paper and join with sticky tape so they make one long line.



Remember to ask a grown-up for help

2

Wrap the long strip around your head and fix in place with sticky tape. You may want to ask an adult to help as it is a bit tricky.

Now make the monster's head. Take a piece of coloured card and draw a shape starting at the bottom. Cut the shape out.

4

Next, tear some little jagged pieces of brown paper and stick them on top of the monster's head. The monster now has some hair!

5

For the eyebrows, tear out some bushy eyebrow shapes from the same piece of paper that you used for the hair. Stick these to the monster head using the glue stick.

Using the black pen, draw some wavy lines on the monster's forehead to give him some wrinkles.

For the bolts, take some silver card and draw two 'T' shapes. Carefully cut these out but remember to be careful when using scissors as they are sharp. Glue the bolts either side of the monster head.

Take the loop that you made earlier. Turn the monster head over and stick the loop on to the head using the glue stick.

Once the mask is dry you can try it on! You can also make a werewolf mask with shaggy hair and pointy ears or a giant egg head mask with cotton wool hair and eyebrows.
